Wairarapa Citizens Advice Bureau is a registered Incorporated Society under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908, and a Charitable entity under the Charities Act 2005.

Our purpose is to provide free, impartial and confidential information, guidance and support to the public of Wairarapa. This includes clients from Sth Wairarapa. We aim to ensure that individuals do not suffer through ignorance of their rights and responsibilities, or of the services available, or through an inability to express their needs effectively. We are all trained volunteers.

We have no sources of funding other than grants. Our operational costs last year totalled \$13114.00 (excl GST). To date this financial year (July 1 2011 to June 30 2012) we have raised \$9000.00. This is made up of Masterton District Council grant of \$1500.00; Carterton District Council grant of \$1000; Community Organisation Grants Scheme of \$2500.00; Lottery Grants Board of \$4000.00

We are seeking a grant of \$500 towards our rent. We rent part of the premises of the local Masonic United Lodge of Masterton at 43 Perry St in Masterton. As our service extends to Sth Wairarapa clients it is important that we maintain our office in the Wairarapa where it can be manned by trained operators familiar with the region.

I enclose copies of our Financial report to the year ended June 30 2011, our Certificate of Incorporation, and a copy of the aims and ethics of NZ Association of Citizens Advice Bureau. I also provide a deposit slip for our Bank Account.

### Reporting Entity:-

The Wairarapa Citizens Advice Bureau Inc is registered under the Incorporated Socities Act 1908.

The reporting entity is Wairarpa Citizens Advice Bureau Inc.

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Framework for Differential Reporting issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand. The entity has taken advantage of all available differential reporting exemptions.

### General Accounting Policies:-

The general accounting policies, recognised as appropriate in the preparation of these financial statements:-

- The measurement base adopted is that of historical cost. Reliance is placed on the fact that the Bureau is a going concern.
- The Financial Statements have been prepared on an Income and Expenditure basis using accrual accounting.

### Particular Accounting Policies:-

The following accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of profit and financial position have been applied.

- 1. Depreciation has been provided for, so as to recognise the absorption of the cost of fixed assets during the year as set out in the Schedule of Fixed Assets and Depreciation.
- The financial statements have been prepared, stating income, expenditure and accrual items exclusive of Goods and Services Tax.

### Changes in Accounting Policies:-

There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies observed in the preparation of these financial statements are consistent with those followed in previous years.


