NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF CLUB LICENCE

Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Greytown Bowling Club Incorporated

The club licence in respect of the premises situated at 55 East Street, Greytown and known as Greytown Bowling Club is renewed. The present conditions of the licence (numbered 44/CLUB/002/2014) shall continue to apply.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- Until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it is renewed.

This licence expires on **26 September 2017**.

CLUB-LICENCE

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **GREYTOWN BOWLING CLUB INCORPORATED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at 55 East Street, Greytown and known as "Greytown Bowling Club", for consumption on the premises, to any person who –

- is a member of the club; or
- is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.

The authority conferred by the licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 8:00am to 11:00pm
- b) the licensee must ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied to any person for consumption on the premises unless the person is –
 - i. an authorised customer;
 - ii. a person who is on the premises at the invitation of an authorised visitor who is also on the premises
- c) the whole of the premises is undesignated
- d) drinking water is to be freely available from the bar to customers at all times when alcohol is available from the bar
- e) food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale of alcohol, a range of choices must be readily available. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted
- f) the following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol: the licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol beverages
- g) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons and persons who are not authorised customers
- h) conditions prescribing steps to be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed:
 - i. The Host Responsibility Policy must be displayed in view of the public
 - ii. Signs must be prominently displayed detailing information regarding alternative forms of transport
 - iii. To ensure the appropriate supervision of the premises a certified manager must be present when alcohol is available for sale during busy periods. Busy has been defined by the club secretary as more than 75 people on the Club premises

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at 55 East Street, Greytown, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Agency on 31 August 2001.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from 55 East Street, Greytown designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- (a) until its expiry date detailed below; OR
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period 3 years after the expiry date.
