DECISION

This is an application by Martinborough Squash Club Incorporated for a renewal club licence in respect of premises situated at Todds Road, Martinborough, known as "Martinborough Squash Club".


The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, as empowered by Section 134 of the Act, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in Sections 105, 106(2) and 131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal club licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises, subject to the following conditions –

The following conditions are consistent with the style of club licence sought:

1. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Sunday, 11 am to 11 pm.
2. The premises is undesignated.
3. The club must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the club is open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol refreshments.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to members and their guests free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Substantial food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale and supply of alcohol. Menus must be visible, food should be actively promoted and readily available.
6. The licensee must provide free accurate and comprehensive information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licenced premises.
7. The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued is displayed on the inside of the premises in a prominent location.
8. The licensee must ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied to any person for consumption on the premises unless the person is an authorised customer or an authorised visitor.
9. The Club must have a secretary at all times.
10. Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the secretary of the District Licensing Committee.
11. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.
12. The licensee must ensure that, while the premises are open for the sale or supply of alcohol, no person consumes on the premises any alcohol not sold or supplied on the premise by the licence.

CLUB-LICENCE

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **MARTINBOROUGH SQUASH CLUB INCORPORATED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at Todds Road, Martinborough and known as "Martinborough Squash Club", for consumption on the premises, to any person who –

- is a member of the club; or
- is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.

The authority conferred by the licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Sunday, 11 am to 11 pm.
2. The premises is undesignated.
3. The club must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the club is open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol refreshments.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to members and their guests free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Substantial food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale and supply of alcohol. Menus must be visible, food should be actively promoted and readily available.
6. The licensee must provide free accurate and comprehensive information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licenced premises.
7. The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued is displayed on the inside of the premises in a prominent location.
8. The licensee must ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied to any person for consumption on the premises unless the person is an authorised customer or an authorised visitor.
9. The Club must have a secretary at all times.
10. Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the secretary of the District Licensing Committee.
11. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.
12. The licensee must ensure that, while the premises are open for the sale or supply of alcohol, no person consumes on the premises any alcohol not sold or supplied on the premise by the licence.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at Todds Road, Martinborough, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on 24 February 2017.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The upstairs entrance from the carpark is designated as the principal entrance.


DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- (a) until its expiry date detailed below; OR
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period 3 years after the expiry date.
