1. Background

1.1 Water Race Subcommittee

This year, the Water Race Subcommittee requested oversight of all water race realignment requests. Previously the majority of realignment requests were considered by officers after receipt of engineering and other reports as necessary. This is a change of process and the relevant Council teams have added the governance approval step to their processes.

FENZ have requested a Moroa Water Race realignment as part of their new Fire Station build in Greytown. Although the realignment work hasn't commenced, consideration of the request by the Subcommittee was considered well into the consent process. The request was endorsed by both the Water Race Subcommittee and the Assets and Services Committee.

For completeness a historical Moroa Water Race realignment decision for 78 Kuratawhiti Street, Greytown was reported to the Water Race Subcommittee and Assets and Services Committee for noting.
