<u> Alan Maxwell – Wairarapa Anglican Youth</u>

Alan is employed by the SW Parish to cover Martinborough and Featherston youth and Wellington Diocese up to Pahiatua. Facilitating an Outreach Programme to engage with youth. He has engaged with 194 youth in Featherston and 97 in Martinborough and he is finding out what they want – the youth want to engage. Needs more adult helpers and volunteers to give them acceptance and encouragement. He has connected with the MENZ Shed. Next Term activities include Super Grans and Breadmaking. Julie suggested that they apply to MCB for funding now that the R2R group has folded. Alan has accepted invitation to join CSRWP.

<u>Julie Brunton - Social Sector Trial Lead</u>

A cross government initiative including Health, Justice, Education, Social Development, Police. Trial being run in 16 communities to try and get the agencies working and collaborating together to use funds coming into the community more effectively, as well as sharing resources and information. Locally looking at needs of our community, emerging trends, funding etc. Working with CC website Youth Reserve www.youthreserve.co.nz so that it becomes the go-to website for young people. They are looking at transport (3 free rides to school if you miss the bus) and reducing truancy. They are providing a Balcony Overview of all the Agencies.
