<b>Key issues from meeting</b>	Helen has completed the GRAFFITI PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT POLICY which was discussed and ratified. City Care report unavailable. Helen reported that there were 3 tags in Martinborough and also in Featherston and the cameras in Fstn are doing a good job. Fstn Facebook page is a good source of information. Police reported that there are very few complaints of wilful damage and Ian has met with Martinborough Community Patrol. Hope noted that Kuranui is running a programme for "taggers" to do artwork. Featherston NS – Robyn has 10 groups with 7 in the pipeline waiting with 73 households so far joined up which is 5.5% of all the households. 10% is covered in Masterton. There is a get- together in October with Lionesses, Police, DHB and Emergency Services followed by afternoon tea. Martinborough NS – Sue has contacted all the names registered at the Martinborough meeting. Slow to get the first group up and running but will contact again. Discussion on bridge/road closure information and Ian advised that the Police District Command & Communication Centre with Road Closures/Conditions is open 24x7.
