General	Cr Craig & I attended the Waste Forum which was held in Carterton Events Centre. Mike & Aaron gave a brief outline of the guidelines they have developed for preventing and dealing with Asbestos at Transfer stations and also managing the unexpected dumping of products containing asbestos. A total of 360 items contain asbestos. IQ Container Homes – use either 20 or 40 foot containers which are eco-friendly homes – with zero waste from the construction site. They estimate that 50% of what goes to the landfill is construction waste. The analogy is that 4tonnes of waste is equivalent to the size of a hippopotamus Wellington CC are investigating a weekly food waste collection. Residents will be provided with either a small
