	The Youth Survey is being collated, findings will be released to a variety of agencies once finished
	Whakapuaki Whanau programme has had 17 referrals in 1 week from a variety of sources mainly CYFS and Justice, many of the client families are from Masterton. There is now a waiting list. A new social worker starts 1 July.
	Youth Services Contract- the age limit has been extended to 19 from 18. This will mean more clients but also more funding. The new contract numbers and targets are still unknown although the contract begins on 1 July.
Specific item/s for Council consideration	
General	Ritchie Day- South Wairarapa Police Sergeant introduced himself and gave an update of how the Police were working in Carterton and Sth Wairarapa. He is investigating a programme that will hopefully be implemented at Kuranui in either Term 4 or Term 1 next year for 25 kids. Approval from Senior Police is needed before it can be run. The cost is approx. \$16,000.
