# SALE AND SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL PROJECT TEAM

## **Purpose of Report**

To inform Councillors about the formation of a Sale and Supply of Alcohol Project Team to assist with the implementation of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

#### Recommendations

Officers recommend that the Council:

- 1. Receive the information.
- 2. Grant the Project Team the authority to work with other Territorial Authorities.
- 3. Grant the Project Team the authority to make recommendations to Council.
- 4. Grant the Project Team the authority to set up a consultation process with key stakeholders and the community.

## 1. Executive Summary

Council is required to establish a District Licensing Committee. The Committee will be responsible for considering applications made under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) and will need to be in place by 18 December 2013.

Council has agreed that it intends to develop a Wairarapa Local Alcohol Policy (LAP). A provisional LAP can be publicly notified from 18 December 2013.

A SWDC project team has been set up consisting of Councillor Napier, Councillor Riddell and Officers Vanessa Tipoki (Acting Group Manager Planning and Environment), Bronwyn Johnson (Environmental Health Team Leader) and Russell Hooper (Resource Management Planner).

The project team will be responsible for ensuring that Council is ready for implementation of the Act.

## 1.1 Legal Implications

Section 186 of the Act states that each territorial authority must appoint a licensing committee to deal with licensing matters in its district.

#### 1.2 Financial Considerations

Money has been allocated in the Draft 2013/14 Annual Plan.
