# D2. Waste Water Matters Report (Purchase of Land)

Mr Crimp tabled the report and councillors discussed the following.

That Baker and Associates had valued the land at \$23.5k/ha, however the property was being marketed at \$35k/ha as dairy farms outside the region were selling at and above this price point. QV were now valuing dairy farms in the South Wairarapa at approximately \$33k/ha.

That land purchase break-even point for Council's waste water project was approximately \$63/ha.

That the land could be returned to dairy quality pasture within 1-2 years of stopping irrigation.

That mitigation, as required by GWRC, for the waste water consent applications as lodged would have an unbudgeted rates impact.

# COUNCIL RESOLVED (DC2014/208):

- 1. To receive the information.
- 2. To agree to lodge two tenders, one under SWDC and one under a blind bidder.
- 3. That a working group consisting of the Audit and Risk Committee members, Cr Montgomerie and Mayor Staples work with the Chief Executive to ascertain the level of the bids.
- 4. To note that the blind bid will be "above market".
- 5. To agree it is prudent to tender above market as the land is of strategic importance.
- 6. To note the cost comparisons between the land purchase option and the high rate treatment plant option.
- 7. To note that the purchase of land is less risky than purchasing a high treatment plant as it can be sold if circumstances allow.

- 8. To note that the purchase of land is potentially environmentally more friendly than a HRT plant.
- 9. To note that this purchase is not consulted on specifically in the LTP, however Council has stated the overall cost of the three schemes will be in to order of \$34M, and that this option is within this cost envelope.
- 10. To note that there will be a rates impact that was not contemplated in the LTP or Annual Plan.
- 11. To note that this purchase is not in line with the resource consent application currently lodged.
- 12. To note that borrowing covenants are not breached following this purchase, however if interest rates rise materially over the next 5 years this may be the case.
