<b>Key issues from meeting</b>	<p><b>Committee Membership</b> -Cr David Montgomerie and Ben Winder resigned from committee, Sian Pattersen and AJ, need to follow up if they are still keen.  New members are need 1 must be an elected member</p> <p><b>Sites-</b> 3 more private ownership sites ruled out as 2 on Maori land with little hope of purchase and 1 Main St site now sold  Pensioner flats site on West St – too many neighbours and contaminated site  Arbor reserve and surrounds- too many trees limited space, next to newly refurbished Railway Goods Shed  Collier Reserve – too many neighbours and trees  Greytown Primary School Board has decided not to proceed with track in school grounds.  Discussion re proposed Sports Hub- group believes the project is longer term, Wheels Park would not a priority initially.  Of 14 sites considered on spreadsheet Pierce St site is the preferred site. It is close to other facilities ie Rail Trail and dog park, it is a large site with room for parking, etc, a small number of neighbours. Owned by SWDC, Council has approved site for a wheel's park.</p>
