DECISION

These are applications by TRUST HOUSE LTD for renewal of on and off-licences in respect of premises situated at Fitzherbert Street, Featherston, known as "Featherston Supervalve".

The applicant also seeks to vary the licence conditions in accordance with s.120 of The Act.

RECOMMENDED CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

The licence is subject to the following conditions

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day:
2. No alcohol may be sold other than—
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm.
4. The only area delineated on the attached plan is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol
5. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample:
6. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of off-licence renewal.

The applications were duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licences until 28 September 2017, and authorise the issue of replacement licences and notices of renewal.

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Trust House Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **Fitzherbert Street, Featherston**, and known as "**Featherston Supervalu**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day;
2. No alcohol may be sold other than—
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm.
4. The only area delineated on the attached plan is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol
5. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample;
6. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **Fitzherbert Street, Featherston** are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **South Wairarapa District Licensing Agency on 18 August 2014.**

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **Fitzherbert Street, Featherston** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
