APPLICATION

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

The following conditions are consistent with the style of on licence sought:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day.
- b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 5.00 pm

- c) The premises is undesignated.
- d) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied as a free sample.
- e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display:
 - a. At each principal entrance to the premises, the ordinary operating hours during which the sale of alcohol is permitted.
 - b. A copy of the licence and all conditions subject to which it is issued, to the inside of the premises so to be easily read by all people entering at each principal entrance.
 - c. At every point of sale for alcohol, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of off-licence renewal.

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, John Douglas and Katherine Gouldstone is authorised to sell or deliver liquor on or from the premises situated at 226 Te Muna Road, Martinborough, and known as Te Hera Estate, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of liquor on the premises.
