DECISION

This is an application by Old Vine Investments Limited for a renewal off-licence in respect of premises situated at 32 Cambridge Road, Martinborough, known as "Cambridge Road Vineyard".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

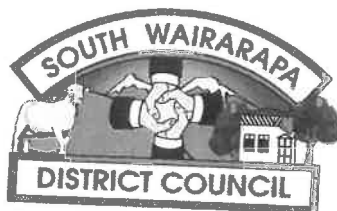
We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal off-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

The licence may be issued with the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day;
2. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made-
 - a. On the premises; or
 - b. From grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm.
4. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample
5. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
6. Remote Sales: The holder of this licence must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age

Old Vine Investments Limited



- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it is renewed.

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Old Vine Investments Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **32 Cambridge Road, Martinborough**, and known as **Cambridge Road Vineyard**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1:00pm on Anzac Day; and
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises at any time on Easter Sunday unless it is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made –
 - i. On the premises; or
 - ii. From produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- (c) Alcohol may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9:00am – 9:00pm
- (d) The premises is **undesignated**
- (e) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied as a complimentary sample.
- (e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **32 Cambridge Road, Martinborough**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee** on **1 October 2014**.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **32 Cambridge Road, Martinborough** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
