

**OFF-LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **Huangaaru Terrace Vineyard Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **415 Te Muna Road, RD 1, Martinborough**, and known as **"Big Sky Wines"**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises. ENDORSEMENT: Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

**CONDITIONS:****Remote sales**

1. A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day.
2. The holder of this licence must ensure that any alcohol sold by remote sale is not delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00 pm on any day or before 6.00 am on the next day.
3. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, or Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
4. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises at any time on Easter Sunday unless it is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made –
  - (i) On the premises; or
  - (ii) From produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
5. The holder of this licence must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of off-licence sought.

**THE LICENSED PREMISES**

The premises, situated at **415 Te Muna Road, RD 1, Martinborough** are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee** on the **14<sup>th</sup> May 2015**.

**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 3 years commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

**DECISION**

This is an application by Huangarua Terrace Vineyard Limited for an off-licence in respect of premises situated at 415 Te Muna Road, RD 1, Martinborough, known as "Big Sky Wines".

**THE LICENSED PREMISES**

The premises, situated at 415 Te Muna Road, RD 1, Martinborough are more precisely identified in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on 14th May 2015.

**DECISION**

The application is in respect of premises in which the principal business is small boutique winery with remote sales only of wine produced at the vineyard. The website is currently under development.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off-licence pursuant to s.17. The remote sales endorsement is pursuant to s.40 of the Act and applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

**CONDITIONS FOR OFF LICENCE:**

**Remote sales**

1. A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day.
2. The holder of this licence must ensure that any alcohol sold by remote sale is not delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00 pm on any day or before 6.00 am on the next day.
3. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, or Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
4. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises at any time on Easter Sunday unless it is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made –
  - (i) On the premises; or
  - (ii) From produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
5. The holder of this licence must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.
