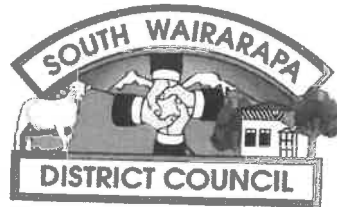
The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.


The on licence in respect of the premises situated at 52 New York Street, Martinborough and known as Peppers Parehua Martinborough is renewed.

ON-LICENCE
(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), **Parehua (Martinborough) Holdings Ltd** is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at **52 New York Street, Martinborough** and known as **Peppers Parehua Martinborough**, to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not –
 - i) residing or lodging on the premises; or
 - ii) present on the premises to dine
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 12:00pm to 12:00am
- (c) The whole of the premise is designated as an undesignated area .
- (d) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers for consumption while the premises are open for business at the following place or places: **Tables and bar area**
- (e) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are open for the sale of liquor in accordance with the menu submitted with the application for a licence, or variations of that menu of a similar range and standard.
- (f) The licensee must ensure that there is available at all times for sale and consumption, at reasonable prices, a range of non alcoholic refreshments and low alcohol beverages.
- (i) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of liquor.
- (j) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of liquor to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **52 New York Street, Martinborough**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Agency on **5 August 2011**

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **52 New York Street, Martinborough** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) Either –
 - i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
 - i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
