DECISION

This is an application by **Siam Kitchen Limited** for a renewal on-licence in respect of premises situated at **2-4 Memorial Square, Martinborough** known as "**Siam Kitchen**"

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a **restaurant**.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal on-licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

The licence may issue with the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises to dine.
- b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 10.00 am to 12.00 midnight
- c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers at all times while the premises are open for business.
- d) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol. The food available must be in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.
- e) The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol beverages.
- f) A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- g) The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
- h) The responsible consumption of alcohol is to be promoted at all times by instigating and maintaining the steps outlined in the application for the licence and displaying the host responsibility policy at all times.
- i) The Licensee must display:
 - i. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - ii. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - iii. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.

ON-LICENCE
(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), **Siam Kitchen Limited** is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at **2-4 Memorial Square, Martinborough** and known as "**Siam Kitchen**", to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a **restaurant**.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises to dine.
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 10.00 am to 12.00 midnight
3. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers at all times while the premises are open for business.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol. The food available must be in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol beverages.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of an on-licence.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **2-4 Memorial Square, Martinborough**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on **10 October 2016**

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **2-4 Memorial Square, Martinborough** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

(a) Either –


- i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but

(b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –

- i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or

If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
