DECISION

This is an application by Paula Bevege Event Design and Planning Limited for an on-licence in respect of premises situated at 1498 State Highway 2, Featherston, known as "Rose and Smith at Tauherenikau"

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a function centre.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

REASON FOR DECISION:

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Licensing Inspector, the Police and the Ministry of Health, who do not oppose the issue of the licence. In addition no objections have been raised. The District Licensing chair acting pursuant to s.99 of the Act therefore accordingly grants the On Licence to Rose and Smith at Tauherenikau.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises, subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS:

- (a) Alcohol may only be available for sale, supply or consumption on the following days and during the following hours:  

**Monday to Sunday 8:00 am to 1:00 am the following day**
- (b) No alcohol may be sold, supplied or consumed on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not –
  - present on the premises to dine
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (d) At all times when the premises are open for selling, supplying or consumption of alcohol, there must be a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages and low-alcohol drinks available for purchase at reasonable prices.
- (e) Food must be available for consumption at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol. The range must be in accordance with the menu submitted with this application or of a similar range and standard. Food must be actively promoted and available within a reasonable time of ordering.
- (f) A properly appointed certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol and their name must be prominently displayed.
- (g) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
  - Implement and maintain the Host Responsibility Policy submitted with the application for the licence.
  - The licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing the availability of assistance and information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
  - The licensee must implement and maintain steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- (h) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale, supply or consumption of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:

A restriction of sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age.

- Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (i) The whole of the premises is designated as an “undesigned” area. As outlined on the site plan dated 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019.
- (j) The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed at each principal entrance so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- (k) A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport & staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

**ON-LICENCE**  
(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), **Paula Bevege Event Design and Planning Limited** is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at **1498 State Highway 2, Featherston** and known as "**Rose and Smith at Tauherenikau**", to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a **function centre**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may only be available for sale, supply or consumption on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 8:00 am to 1:00 am the following day**
- (b) No alcohol may be sold, supplied or consumed on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not –
- present on the premises to dine
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (d) At all times when the premises are open for selling, supplying or consumption of alcohol, there must be a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages and low-alcohol drinks available for purchase at reasonable prices.
- (e) Food must be available for consumption at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol. **THE LICENSED PREMISES**

The premises, situated at **1498 State Highway 2, Featherston**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on **27th August 2018**.

**DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S**


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **1498 State Highway 2, Featherston** is designated as the principal entrance.

**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) Either –
- i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either
- i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
