


PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), ZN Agri Limited is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at 133 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough and known as "Luna Estate", to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a restaurant

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

It is recommended that the licence be issued subject to following conditions:

Endorsement:

Section 38 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to deliver alcohol from the premises and sell it on any other premises for consumption on those other premises by people attending a reception, function, or other social gathering promoted by a person or association of people other than the licensee.

Alcohol may only be available for sale, supply or consumption on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 8:00 am to 1:00 pm the following day

No alcohol may be sold, supplied or consumed on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not -· present on the premises to dine

- (b) Drinking water is to be freely available at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (c) At all times when the premises are open for selling, supplying or consumption of alcohol, there must be a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages and low-alcohol drinks available for purchase at reasonable prices.
- Food must be available for consumption at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol. The range must be in accordance with the menu submitted with this application or of a similar range and standard. Food must be actively promoted and available within a reasonable time of ordering.
- A properly appointed certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol and their name must be prominently displayed.
- (f) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
 - Implement and maintain the Host Responsibility Policy submitted with the application for the licence.
 - The licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing the availability of assistance and information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
 - The licensee must implement and maintain steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale, supply or consumption of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - A restriction of sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age.
 - Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- The whole of the premises is designated as an "undesignated" area. (h)
- (i) The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed at each principal entrance so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport & staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at 133 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on 28th August 2019.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from 133 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

(a) Either -

Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or

If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but íi. STRICT

(b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either

Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued

DECISION

This is an application by **ZN Agri Limited** for an on-licence in respect of premises situated at **133 Puruatanga Road**, **Martinborough**, known as "Luna Estate"

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a **restaurant**.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises, subject to the following conditions:

REASON FOR DECISION:

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Chief Licensing Inspector, the Police and the Medical Officer of Health, who do not oppose the issue of the licence. In addition no public objections have been received. The South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s.99 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants ZN Agri Limited (Luna Estate), the new ON Licence, subject to the Conditions (a) - (k) above and 1-3 below.

The applicant's attention is drawn to ss.56, 57 and 214 (3) of the Act obliging the holder of an on-licence to display:-

- At each principal entrance to the premsies a sign attached to the inside or outside
 of the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the
 entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will
 be open for the sale of alcohol; <u>AND</u>
- A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the interior
 of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal
 entrance; <u>AND</u>
- 3. A sign prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at 133 Puruantanga Road, Martinborough are more precisely identified in a plan received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on 28/08/1928th August 2019.
