### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **WAIRARAPA BRANCH NZ HOLSTEIN FRESIAN ASSOCIATION** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **Tauherenikau Race Course, State Highway 2 Featherston** and known as **Wairarapa Racing Club** to any person attending the following occasion or event:

#### Quiz Night and Dinner

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### RECOMMENDED LICENCE CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**24 June 2015 3.00pm to 9.00pm**
2. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcoholic refreshments
3. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied
4. Drinking water is to be freely available
5. The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Quiz Night and Dinner** to be held at **Tauherenikau Race Course, State Highway 2 Featherston** and known as **Wairarapa Racing Club**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

**RECOMMENDED LICENCE CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**24 June 2015 3.00pm to 9.00pm**
- (b) The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcoholic refreshments
- (c) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied
- (d) Drinking water is to be freely available
- (e) A copy of this licence must be displayed at each point of sale so as to be easily read by persons present on the premises.
- (f) The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - a) (ii) if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

#### **Executive Summary:**

The Wairarapa Branch of the NZ Holstein Friesian Association seeks a special licence to sell and supply alcohol at the Holstein Friesian NZ Annual Conference 2015.

No opposition or concerns have been reported by the reporting agencies.

Section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 sets out the criteria that the Inspector must enquire into and report on, and in turn the District Licensing Committee must consider when determining this application.

#### **STATUTORY CRITERIA**

##### ***The object of the Act***

The applicant has provided details which demonstrate that suitable measures will be undertaken to ensure responsible sales and/or supply of alcohol and that harm will be minimised.

***The nature of the particular event:***

The event is a quiz afternoon and evening dinner to be held on the third day of the four day conference. Entry is restricted to registered members who are attending the conference. The event is expected to attract approximately 100 guests with a probable age distribution of 25 to 80 years.

***Suitability of the applicant:***

I believe that the applicant is suitable and has suitable management of the event.

***The amenity and the good order of the locality would be reduced to no more than a minor extent by the issue of the licence***

The special licence is for a limited time within the grounds of the Tauherenikau Race Course.

There is no reason to believe that the amenity and good order of the locality would be likely to be reduced, by more than a minor extent, by the effects of the issue of the licence.

***The days and hours during which the applicant proposes to sell alcohol***

24 June 2015 3.00pm to 9.00pm

***Whether the applicant has appropriate systems, staff and training***

Maria Berry has been identified as the duty manager. She holds a current manager's certificate (044/GM/746/2010).

***Designation of premises:***

A designation is not necessary for this premises.

***Provision of food, non-alcoholic and low-alcoholic drinks & transport assistance:***

Food is provided as part of the ticket price and includes canapés followed by roast pork, ham, vegetables and desert. Non-alcoholic beverages include soft drinks and orange juice. Fruit juice and water will be freely available on tables. Low alcohol beer will be provided (Amstel Light). A bus service has been arranged to provide transport.

***Any matters in reports.***

- Police have inquired into the application and offers no opposition.
- Public Health has inquired into the application and offers no opposition.

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

**24 June 2015 3.00pm to 9.00pm**

- (b) The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcoholic refreshments
- (c) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied
- (d) Drinking water is to be freely available
