DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

- Appropriate and accurate advice regarding safe transport options will be available to any customer who enquires.
- 6. A copy of this licence must be displayed at each point of sale so as to be easily read by persons present on the premises.
- 7. The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested
