

Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **DRY RIVER WINES LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **90 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough** and known as **Dry River Wines** to any person attending the following occasion or event:

Toast Martinborough 2015

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

LICENCE CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Sunday 15 November 2015 - 10:00am to 6:30pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager nominated by the licence to be responsible for managing the sale and supply of alcohol must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: ticket holders presenting an official Toast Martinborough wristband and festival glass.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.

9. Alcohol must be supplied only in a festival wine glass
10. A maximum of one serve per person per sale.
11. Pour volumes not to exceed:
 - a. 75 ml for a taste
 - b. 150 ml glass

13. The licensee must comply with the Alcohol Management Plan (AMP) appended to this licence

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for ***Toast Martinborough 2015*** to be held at **90 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough** and known as ***Dry River Wines***, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

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3. A certificated manager nominated by the licence to be responsible for managing the sale and supply of alcohol must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.

6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: ticket holders presenting an official Toast Martinborough wristband and festival glass.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
9. Alcohol must be supplied only in a festival wine glass
10. A maximum of one serve per person per sale.
11. Pour volumes not to exceed:
 - a. 75 ml for a taste
 - b. 150 ml glass
13. The licensee must comply with the Alcohol Management Plan (AMP) appended to this licence
