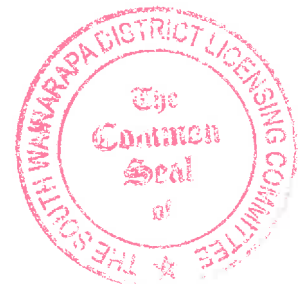

- (d) A reasonable range of food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied
- (e) Drinking water is to be freely available from the bar and maintained throughout the event

- Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Ngawi Big 3 2016** to be held at **Ngawi Community Hall & adjacent marquee, 3109 Cape Palliser Road Featherston** and known as **Ngawi Community Hall**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. I grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, I set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

LICENCE CONDITIONS

(a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

Friday 19 February 2016	1pm to 12.00 midnight
Saturday 20 February 2016	1pm to 2.00 am the following day
Sunday 21 February 2016	10.00am to 10.00pm

- (b) The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments
- (c) The licensee must have available low-alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence
- (d) A reasonable range of food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied
- (e) Drinking water is to be freely available from the bar and maintained throughout the event
- (f) The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested
