Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **FRIENDS OF MARTINBOROUGH SCHOOL** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **Memorial Square, Martinborough 5711** and known as **Memorial Square, Martinborough** to any person attending the following occasion or event:

Round the Vines 2016

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

LICENCE CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Sunday 20th March 2016 9am -3pm
2. Alcohol may be sold or supplied to participants and supporters of the event
3. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: **display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons**
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed: A certificated manager must **be the duty manager for this event.**
5. Drinking water must be freely available at all times while the premises are open for business: **Potable water is to be available at the square**
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
7. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
8. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises (*Note 2*); and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Round the Vines 2016** to be held at **Memorial Square, Martinborough 5711** and known as **Memorial Square, Martinborough**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. I grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

LICENCE CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Sunday 20th March 2016 9am -3pm
- Alcohol may be sold or supplied to participants and supporters of the event
- The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: **display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons**
- The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed: A certificated manager must **be the duty manager for this event**.
- Drinking water must be freely available at all times while the premises are open for business: **Potable water is to be available at the square**
- Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
- The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises (*Note 2*); and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty
