DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for to be held at 19 Kitchener Street, Martinborough, Bell Street, Featherston and 89 Main Street, Grevtown and known as Council chambers, Anzac Hall, Greytown Town Centre, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
 - a. Four separate nights, spaced evenly throughout a 12 month period, occurring only on weekdays.
 - 7.00 pm to 8.30 pm.
- 2. The premises is designated as 'supervised'.
- Alcohol is to be supplied to quests attending the event by a maximum of two staff.
- Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
- The licensee must have non-alcoholic beverages available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply of alcohol.
- The Licensee must display signage as follows: 7.
 - a. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
- Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: invited guests.
- Information on transport assistance is to be freely given to those people attending the event if requested.
- 10. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding supply of alcohol to prohibited persons.
 - Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol. (i)
 - If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must (ii) be requested.

 - b. 7.00 pm to 8.30 pm.

- 3. Alcohol is to be supplied to guests attending the event by a maximum of two staff.
- Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
- 6. The licensee must have non-alcoholic beverages available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply of alcohol.
- 7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
- 8. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: invited quests.
- Information on transport assistance is to be freely given to those people attending the event if requested.
- 10. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding supply of alcohol to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol.
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
