IN THE MATTER of an application by **Foley Family Wines Limited** for a Special Licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act in respect of premises situated at **89 Martins Road, Martinborough** and known as **Te Kairanga Vineyard**

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **TK Markets** to be held at **89 Martins Road, Martinborough** and known as **Te Kairanga Vineyard** where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Sunday 5th November 2017, Sunday 3rd December 2017, Sunday 7th January 2018, Sunday 4th February 2018,
Sunday 4th March 2018 and Sunday 1st April 2018. All events from **10am to 4pm**.
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
4. Substantial food items of a reasonable range and price must be available for consumption at the event at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
5. The event must have a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages available for purchase at reasonable prices at all times that the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises ; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: market attendees.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol.
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **FOLEY FAMILY WINES LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **89 Martins Road, Martinborough** and known as **Te Kairanga Vineyard** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **TK Markets**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

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2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
4. Substantial food items of a reasonable range and price must be available for consumption at the event at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
5. The event must have a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages available for purchase at reasonable prices at all times that the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
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 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
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 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: market attendees.
