## **DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **140th Jubilee Dinner** to be held at **62 Bell Street**, **Featherston** and known as **ANZAC Hall.** where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours: Saturday 2 June 2018 6.00 pm to 11.00pm
- (b) The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments
- (c) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied
- (d) Drinking water is to be freely available
- (e) The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - (i) At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
  - (ii) A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises (and
  - (iii) A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- (f) The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested
