**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Inspiring Women Fundraiser** to be held at **38 Donald Street, Featherston** and known as **Tarureka Estate**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

**Reason for decision:**

This is an application for a Special Licence to hold a fundraising event for St Teresa's School in Featherston. On reading the Inspector's Report the DLC has no reason to believe that the applicant is not suitable to hold a Special Licence for this event.

**Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following day and during the following hours:  
Friday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018, 6:15 pm to 11:00 pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: ticket holders
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

### Special Licence

#### **Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012**

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **FRIENDS OF ST TERESA'S ASSOCIATION** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **38 Donald Street, Featherston** and known as **Tarureka Estate** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Inspiring Women Fundraiser**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### **Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following day and during the following hours:  
Friday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018, 6:15 pm to 11:00 pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
