DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for an off-site Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for a VIP cellar door event to be held at 14 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough and known as Ata Rangi Vineyard, where alcohol will be tasted on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Reason for decision:

On reading the Inspector's Report and recommendations the DLC has no reason to believe the Applicant is unsuitable to hold the Off site Special Licence for Wine Tasting and the Licence is granted accordingly.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

 Wine tasting may be conducted on the extended licensed premises only on the following day and hours:

Saturday 27th October 2018, 11:00 am to 4:00 pm

- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the supply and tasting of wine.
- 4. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises at the cellar door so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and

- c. A sign prominently displayed at each tasting location, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 5. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: invited guests.
- 6. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding supply to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
