DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Staff Social events and Christmas Function** to be held at **6 Wakelin Street, Greytown** and known as **Kuranui College Staff Room and Courtyard,** where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Reason for decision:

On reading the Licensing Inspector's report and supporting information the District Licensing Chair acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act therefore accordingly grants the Special Licence to the Kuranui College Board of Trustees, subject to the following conditions.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

- 2. The staffroom and courtyard area is designated 'supervised'.
- 3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 4. The person nominated by the licensee to be responsible for the sale and supply of alcohol must be on duty at all times the conveyance is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
- Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu.

- supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
- 6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.

 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
