

Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **GREYTOWN HERITAGE TRUST** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 63 Main Street, Greytown, and known as St Andrew's Church to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Annual Heritage Address

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. [Thursday 31 October 2019, 7:00 pm to 7:30 pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Greytown Heritage Trust Annual Heritage Address** to be held at 63 Sain Street, Greytown, and known as St Andrew's Church, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Reason for decision:

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Licensing Inspector, the Police and the Medical Officer of Health, who do not oppose the issue of the licence.

The District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants the Special Licence to the Greytown Heritage Trust subject to the following conditions 1 – 7.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Thursday 31 October 2019, 7:00 pm to 7:30 pm

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
