

Resurfacing Kitchener Street in Martinborough

7 March 2023



Dear Resident/Business Manager

Roadworks will start in mid-March to resurface State Highway 53 Kitchener Street in Martinborough. The asphalt resurfacing will upgrade the condition of the highway from Memorial Square to Princess Street.

Following discussion with South Wairarapa District Council, the work will take place during five daytime shifts of 7am to 7pm, starting Monday 20 March and finishing on Friday 24 March. Please be aware that wet weather may force the postponement of work to a later date.

As shown in the map over the page, the resurfacing will proceed in stages, block by block starting from Memorial Square. We will close two blocks to through-traffic each day to allow for machinery movements with a signposted detour route, except for the fifth day when stop/go traffic control will be in place at the Princess Street intersection.

We appreciate the work will be inconvenient for the Martinborough community and your guests. We thank you for your patience and trust you will regard the five days as worth the bother for a safer, smoother road surface that will be an asset to your community. Wellington Transport Alliance (WTA) is undertaking the work on behalf of Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency.

Asphalt resurfacing requires machinery that takes up a lot of room. This has a significant impact on how traffic is managed and how the public and our workers are kept safe. Closing the road when there is	The footpaths will remain open for people to use and will be managed by our traffic controllers for your safety. Vehicles cannot park on the street inside the closed road areas. Please use side roads instead. On the fifth day, we will not need a road closure or detour. Instead we will have stop/go traffic control
a good detour available allows us to work quickly and efficiently without causing major disruption. Traffic management	at the Princess Street intersection. Vehicles will not be able to turn at the intersection because of machinery at work. You can drive straight ahead but cannot turn.
We will close two blocks to vehicle traffic each day to allow for machinery movements. Through-traffic should detour via Princess Street, Dublin Street and New York Street. Vehicle access into the closures will be for residents, business staff and deliveries only. Our traffic controllers will assist with access.	Vehicles heading out of or into town will stay on Kitchener Street through the intersection. Vehicles on Princess Street can drive straight ahead but cannot turn into Kitchener Street. NB: We are working with Metlink to ensure the bus service operates efficiently during the works.
