MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT

(14 JUNE 2024)

[1] Following mediation held in Greytown on 12 June 2024 it was agreed to adjourn the mediation to resume in early July. This is to allow the appellant to prepare a revised draft of proposed consent conditions based on the agreements in principle reached at the mediation.

[2] The appellant is to circulate this draft to the parties by 21 June 2024 and parties are encouraged to provide any comments on this draft to the appellant by 27 June 2024. These comments should be restricted to addressing directly the wording of draft conditions proposed by the appellant.

[3] Resumed mediation is now scheduled for 1 July 2024 and all parties are urged to make every effort to attend on this day. It is expected that the mediation will be
