DECISION

This is an application by **Martinborough Rugby Football Club Incorporated** for a renewal club licence in respect of premises situated at **Regent Street, Martinborough**, known as "**Martinborough Rugby Football Club**".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, as empowered by Section 134 of the Act, I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in Sections 105, 106(2) and 131 of the Act and I grant the applicant a renewal club licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

CONDITIONS

The following conditions are consistent with the style of club licence sought:

1. The Club must have a secretary at all times.
2. Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the secretary of the District Licensing Committee.
3. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.
4. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Thursday2.00 pm to midnight
Friday, Saturday and Public Holidays.....12 noon to 1.00am the following day
Sunday.....12 noon to 10 pm
5. While the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol no BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.
6. The club must have at least one properly appointed certified manager.



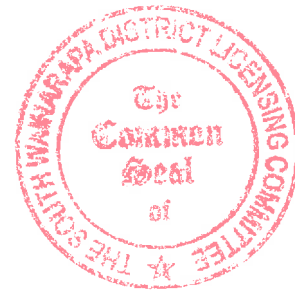
7. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at a time when the club is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
8. Drinking water is to be provided to members and their guests free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
9. At all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol a range of substantive food must be readily available. A minimum of three types of food should be available. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.
10. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licenced premises.
11. Alcohol can be sold and supplied to guests of members of clubs with which the licensee has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.
12. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by persons using the premises.

CLUB-LICENCE

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **MARTINBOROUGH RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB INCORPORATED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at Regent Street, Martinborough 5711 and known as "Martinborough Rugby Football Club", for consumption on the premises, to any person who –

- is a member of the club; or
- is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.

The authority conferred by the licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act

CONDITIONS

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- (a) until its expiry date detailed below; OR
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period 3 years after the expiry date.
