**DECISION**

This is an application by **Greytown Bowling Club Incorporated** for a renewal club licence in respect of premises situated at **55 East Street, Greytown**, known as "**Greytown Bowling Club**".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, as empowered by Section 134 of the Act, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in Sections 105, 106(2) and 131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal club licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

**Reason for decision:**

The decision to renew this club licence has been made noting that the concerns relating to systems around certified managers and the need for additional support systems to be in place for one certified manager has been undertaken and resolved to the inspector's satisfaction.

**Conditions:**

1. Alcohol may be sold, supplied and consumed only on the following days and hours:  
Monday to Sunday, 8:00 am to 11:00 pm
2. Drinking water is to be freely available at all times when the premises is open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
3. At all times when the premises are open for selling, supplying or consumption of alcohol, there must be a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages and low-alcohol drinks available for purchase at reasonable prices.
4. Food must be available for consumption at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol. The range must be in accordance with the menu submitted with this application or of a similar range and standard. Food must be actively promoted and available within a reasonable time of ordering.
5. Information, advice and assistance about alternative transport options must be freely given to guests on the licensed premises.
6. The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued is displayed on the inside of the premises in a prominent location.
7. The responsible consumption of alcohol is to be promoted at all times by instigating and maintaining the steps outlined in the application for the licence and displaying the host responsibility policy at all times.
8. The licensee must ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied to any person for consumption on the premises unless the person is an authorised customer or an authorised visitor.
9. The Club must have a secretary at all times.
10. Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the secretary of the District Licensing Committee.
11. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.
12. The licensee must ensure that, while the premises are open for the sale or supply of alcohol, no person consumes on the premises any alcohol not sold or supplied on the premises by the licensee.

### CLUB-LICENCE

Sections 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Gryetown Bowling Club Incorporated** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **55 East Street, Greytown** and known as "**Greytown Bowling Club**", for consumption on the premises, to any person who –

- is a member of the club; or
- is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.

The authority conferred by the licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act

### **CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold, supplied and consumed only on the following days and hours:  
Monday to Sunday, 8:00 am to 11:00 pm
2. Drinking water is to be freely available at all times when the premises is open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
3. At all times when the premises are open for selling, supplying or consumption of alcohol, there must be a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages and low-alcohol drinks available for purchase at reasonable prices.
4. Food must be available for consumption at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol. The range must be in accordance with the menu submitted with this application or of a similar range and standard. Food must be actively promoted and available within a reasonable time of ordering.
5. Information, advice and assistance about alternative transport options must be freely given to guests on the licensed premises.
6. The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued is displayed on the inside of the premises in a prominent location.
7. The responsible consumption of alcohol is to be promoted at all times by instigating and maintaining the steps outlined in the application for the licence and displaying the host responsibility policy at all times.
8. The licensee must ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied to any person for consumption on the premises unless the person is an authorised customer or an authorised visitor.
9. The Club must have a secretary at all times.
10. Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the secretary of the District Licensing Committee.
11. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.
12. The licensee must ensure that, while the premises are open for the sale or supply of alcohol, no person consumes on the premises any alcohol not sold or supplied on the premises by the licensee.

### **THE LICENSED PREMISES**

The premises, situated at **55 East Street, Greytown**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on **25 August 2017**.

### **DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE**


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The upstairs entrance from the carpark is designated as the principal entrance.

### **DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

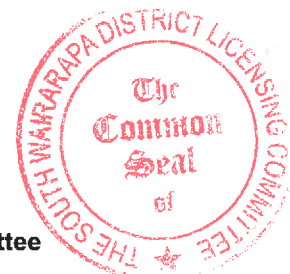
- (a) until its expiry date detailed below; OR
