Except in the case of a conveyance, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application (in Form 7) is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates, within 10 working days of filing with the District Licensing Committee. The Secretary of the District Licensing Committee may waive this requirement if it is deemed impracticable or unreasonable to display the notice.
