<b>Meeting – Date &amp; Venue</b>	WAIRARAPA ROAD SAFETY COUNCIL 23 NOVEMBER, 2016 at REAP House, Masterton
<b>Key issues from meeting</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At 22 November, the national road toll was 288. Unfortunately 7 fatalities in Wairarapa.</li> <li>• Safer Journeys Action Plan 2016 – 2020 will focus on areas of greatest risk and disproportionate harm, and on opportunities for the use of current and emerging technology. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Providing road users with right information at the right time</li> <li>○ Providing a safer system for motorcyclists using education, information, training &amp; emerging technology</li> <li>○ Ensuring roads and roadsides support safer travel by focusing initiatives on high risk roads</li> <li>○ Investigating further use of proven &amp; emerging technologies in vehicles entering the NZ fleet</li> </ul> </li> <li>• WRSC Activities have recently focused on Fatigue/Distraction, Restraints, Motorcycle Safety, Speed, Young Drivers (including 850 attendees at the Nigel Latta presentation in Masterton), Alcohol/drugged driving, Safe Cycling, SADD and 'Carfit' clinics for Senior drivers.</li> </ul>

<b>Specific item/s for Council consideration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The pilot Community Driver Mentor Programme currently has 15 students being mentored, including 5 at Kurunui College. The first graduate has passed his restricted licence and secured work. SWDC put some funding towards this pilot programme. It is hoped that new/external funding will be secured to continue the CDMP in 2017.</li> </ul>
<b>General</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The WRSC has requested the NZ AA to produce A flier/brochure/info card which could be distributed by NGOs such as the WRSC or local AA Management to local car dealers informing them of 'Carfit' clinics and requesting that dealers assist senior drivers in adjusting their new vehicles to 'fit' their height, reach etc.</li> <li>• The RSM has contacted local Highway Patrol and TAG teams working in our region highlighting the potential road risk of slow drivers, especially during holiday periods and requesting that road-policing patrols enforce the legislation requiring slow drivers to move to the side of the road to allow other traffic to safely pass.</li> <li>• Bruce Pauling gave a very comprehensive presentation about the WRSC Activities to the Combined Council Forum on 2 December</li> </ul>
