RELOCATION OF BUS STOP #1812 FITZHERBERT STREET FEATHERSTON

Purpose of Report

To inform Councillors of the relocation of Bus Stop 1812 on Fitzherbert Street Featherston.

Recommendations

Officers recommend that the Council:

1. *Receive the information.*
2. *Resolve to relocate Bus Stop #1812 on the northern side of Fitzherbert Street Featherston to a location 48.5 metres east of Birdwood Street.*

1. Executive Summary

Greater Wellington Regional Council is prepared to relocate the Bus Stop to assist the Development of World War 1 memorial Sculpture Development.

To allow the relocation South Wairarapa District Council needs to resolve the proposed location.

2. Background

As part of the World War 1 Memorial Sculpture Development, Greater Wellington Regional Council as the provider of Wairarapa bus services has been asked to consider the relocation of the existing Bus stop and Bus shelter.

3. Discussion

3.1 Consultation

SWDC officers met with NZTA Senior Safety Engineer, GWRC Asset Advisor, Bus and Ferry Operations on site to determine the viability of relocating the existing bus stop. Consideration was given to location of other bus stop, passenger numbers and proximity to amenities e.g. State Highway 2 pedestrian crossing, Doctor Rooms, Library, playground, public toilets.

Once resolved Greater Wellington Regional Council and Transit Buses will engage with bus patrons about the proposed relocation of the bus stop.

3.2 Legal Implications

The Masterton and South Wairarapa District Councils' Consolidated Bylaw: Section 22 Power to amend by resolution states;

The Council may from time to time by Resolution:

- a) Add Schedules.
- b) Make additions or deletions from the schedules.
- c) Substitute new schedules.

3.3 Location

Fitzherbert Street. The northern side commencing 48.5 metres east of the centreline of Birdwood Street and extending for a distance of 15.0.

4. Conclusion

The costs of the relocation and installation of a bus shelter are being met by Greater Wellington Regional Council.

The proposed site has been assessed in conjunction with the other existing bus stops on Fitzherbert Street and at this stage there is no need to relocate any others. Bus patronage will be monitored.

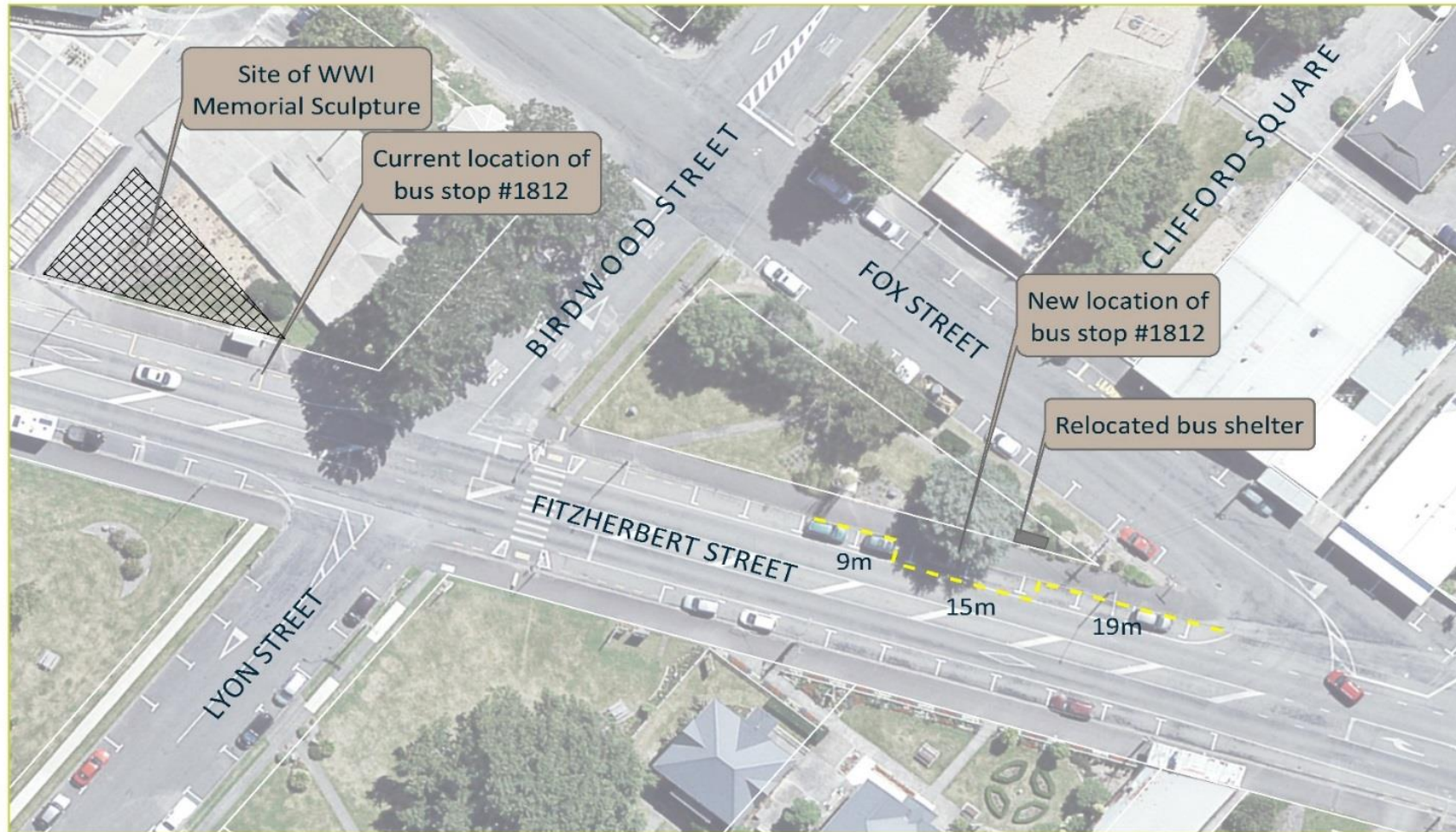
