1. Executive Summary

The Draft Long Term Plan 2015/2025 was released for public consultation on the 1st May 2015. A total of 121 submissions (Appendix 1), have been received resulting in 322 individual requests or comments. The submissions have been summarised and are presented as Appendix 2. Officers have reviewed the submissions and made comments against individual requests.

Council must now hear members of the public who wish to present their submission in person and then decide whether any changes will be made to the Draft Long Term Plan 2015/2025 before it is adopted on the 24 June 2015.
