Roadworks in Featherston, State Highway 2

February 9th 2016

We want to let you know about resurfacing work planned for Tuesday February 9th through Featherston along State Highway 2.

As part of our responsibility to maintain and improve state highways across the country, the NZ Transport Agency will be resurfacing a section of highway through the main centre of Featherston.

You can see the full scope of the project in the diagram at the end of this letter.

How will this work affect me?

While we always aim to do our work with as little disruption as possible, we know that roadworks can be a hassle.

A detour will be in place to accommodate the resurfacing works. If you are heading to Featherston train station, you will need to allow extra time for your journey to reach the station via the detour route.

While the road is being resurfaced there will be no vehicle access or parking along the main street. Parking will be available on side streets, and the footpath will be open for people to access the shops.

A temporary speed limit will be in place during the work, and then around the clock for a couple of days while we sweep up the loose chip and lay new lane markings. For your safety, the safety of our road crews, and to prevent damage to your vehicle, please drive carefully and

stick to the temporary speed limits that will be in place.

Our aim is to start from the southern end of the road so that we minimise any disruption to businesses.

Should bad weather strike work will be postponed until the next suitable day≥
