Official information Request: Implementation costs for speed limit changes as a result of the new Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2024

I am writing to you in response to your request received via transfer from Metlink on 9 April for the following information: *how much it cost for your council to implement speed limit changes as a result of the new Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2024.*

We have assessed your request under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA). I have received information to provide the following response:

The enactment of the speed review (putting in signage, communicating as limits change) is only recently being completed. Therefore, we have provided both the costs actually invoiced to date, plus an estimate of the remaining amounts that we have not yet been invoiced for.

- Speed Management signs \$124,814 + GST to date, with estimated additional \$40,275 due to be invoiced for April 2026. This gives an **estimated total of \$165,089**
- Speed Management review \$3,200 + GST

We did not track internal staff time for this review, so are unable to declare any cost of internal resource.
