CONFIRMING LEVEL CROSSING WORK PLAN FOR SOUTH WAIRARAPA

Kia Ora Janice,

Thank you to you and the team who has worked alongside us to finalise plans for the level crossing upgrades through South Wairarapa. As you know improving safety at level crossings is a crucial part of our efforts to prepare the line for faster moving, and more frequent services from 2029.

We have now completed the planning and design work and have a firm schedule that we are working towards.

Because level crossings are an integrated part of the local roading network, we are required to formally notify Councils of the upgrade plan. This letter is to confirm the final design and timeframes for each level crossing in the South Wairarapa District.

As discussed with Council, the Bell Street and Brandon Street level crossings will be permanent closures for vehicles. Council will be required to apply to LINZ to stop the road under the Local Government Act, which we are happy to support. Both closures have been programmed towards the latter part of 2025 to provide time for the road stopping process to be undertaken. The road closures will be put in place once civil works commence, as both roads will be closed during these works to ensure the safety of the public and our construction crews.

The table on the next page outlines the features of each level crossing upgrade, along with an image of the finished design, and high-level timeframe for the work.
