**DECISION**

This is an application Judy Dell & Page Partnership for a renewal off-licence in respect of premises situated at 137 Te Maire Road, RD 1, Featherston, known as "Te Maire Rise".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and I grant the applicant a renewal off-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption off the premises.

**CONDITIONS OF LICENCE**

1. Alcohol may be sold from the premises at any time on any day, and delivered somewhere else for consumption off the premises, only on the following days and hours  
Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 6.00pm
2. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, or Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
3. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises at any time on Easter Sunday unless it is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made –
  - (i) On the premises; or
  - (ii) From produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated
4. No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day, on any day of the week
5. The Licensee must follow the procedures set out in Regulation 14 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 to ensure that neither the purchaser nor the person to whom alcohol is delivered is a minor.
6. The Licensee must display on its website, in its catalogue and/or on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely:
  - a. the licence holder's name and licence number;
  - b. the date on which the licence expires;
  - c. a legible image of the licence or a clearly identified link to such an image

**The conditions sought are consistent with the style of off-licence renewal.**
