DECISION

This is an application Kishan Private Limited for a renewal off-licence in respect of premises situated at 21 Fitzherbert Street, Featherston, known as "Thirsty Liquor".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.


We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal off-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day:
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 10.00pm.**
3. The whole of the premises is designated as **supervised area**:
4. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample:
5. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

**The conditions sought are consistent with the style of off-licence.**

### OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Kishan Private Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **21 Fitzherbert Street, Featherston**, and known as **Thirsty Liquor Featherston**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day:
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 10.00pm.**
3. The whole of the premises is designated as **supervised area**:
4. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample:
5. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

### THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **21 Fitzherbert Street, Featherston**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee** on **14<sup>th</sup> day of October 2014**.

### DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **21 Fitzherbert Street, Featherston** is designated as the principal entrance.

### DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 3 years commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
