DECISION

This is an application Margrain Vineyard Limited for a renewal off-licence in respect of premises situated at Ponatahi Road, Martinborough, known as "Margrain Vineyard".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and I grant the applicant a renewal off-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption off the premises

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

The licence is subject to the following conditions

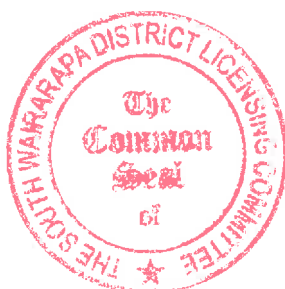
1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day:
2. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated:
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 8.00 am to 8.00 pm
4. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample.
5. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of off-licence renewal.

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act) **Margrain Vineyard Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver liquor on or from the premises situated at **Ponatahi Road, Martinborough** and known as "**Margrain Vineyard**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of liquor on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

The following conditions are consistent with the style of on licence sought:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day;
2. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated;
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 8.00 am to 8.00 pm
4. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample.
5. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **Ponatahi Road, Martinborough** are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee** on **1st August 2016**

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **Ponatahi Road, Martinborough** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 3 years commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
