OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Martinborough Brewery Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver liquor on or from the premises situated at **10 Ohio Street, Martinborough**, and known as **Martinborough Brewery**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of liquor on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS FOR OFF LICENCE

- a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day.
- b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 8.00 am to 10.00 pm
- c) The whole of the premises is designated as a **supervised area**
- d) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied as a free sample
- e) A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- f) The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.

Remote sales

1. A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day.
2. The holder of this licence must ensure that any alcohol sold by remote sale is not delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00 pm on any day or before 6.00 am on the next day.
3. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
4. The holder of this licence must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of Off licence.

THE LICENCED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **10 Ohio Street, Martinborough**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on 22th December 2015**

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **10 Ohio Street, Martinborough** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 3 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

DECISION

This is an application by MARTINBOROUGH BREWERY LIMITED for renewal of an Off Licence in respect of premises situated at 10 Ohio Street, Martinborough, known as "Martinborough Brewery (Ohio Street)".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act. I renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 8 January 2019, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal.
