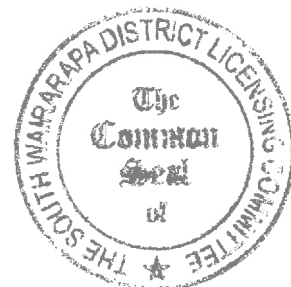
Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

DECISION

This is an application Huangarua Terrace Vineyard Limited for a renewal off-licence in respect of premises situated at 415 Te Muna Road, Martinborough, known as "Big Sky Wines".

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal off-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption off the premises.

RECOMMENDED CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

The licence is subject to the following conditions;

1. A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day.
2. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, or Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
3. No alcohol is to be delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
  - (i) on the premises; or
  - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
4. The licensee must ensure that any alcohol sold by remote sale is not delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00 pm on any day or before 6.00 am on the next day.
5. Condition 4 applies whether the alcohol is delivered by the seller or by some other person.
6. The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.
7. The licensee complies with condition 6 if they comply with a procedure declared by regulation made under the *Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012* to be a reasonable procedure for that purpose.
8. The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale via the Internet must comply with any regulations made under the *Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012* requiring information to be visible on the holder's website when people browse, enter, or otherwise access it.
9. The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale by mail order must comply with any regulations made under the *Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012* requiring information to be published in the holder's catalogues.
10. The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale by telephone must comply with any regulations made under the *Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012* requiring information to be given to callers.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of off-licence with remote sales, endorsed under s 40.
