Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

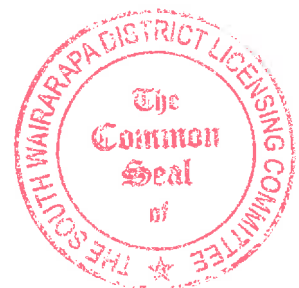
- Until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or

ON-LICENCE

(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), **Salute Restaurant Limited** is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at **82-84 Main Street, Greytown** and known as "**Salute**", to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE:

No variation to the conditions of licence 44/ON/187/2009 have been requested.

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not on the premises to dine
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 11:00am to 1:00am the following day.
3. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers for consumption while the premises are open for business at the following places: drinking water to be provided on tables.
4. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted
6. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed-in the premises.
7. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
8. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending

THE LICENCED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **82-84 Main Street, Greytown**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on **24th August 2015**.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **82-84 Main Street, Greytown** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) Either –
 - i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
 - i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
