DECISION

This is an application by WHAREKAUHAU COUNTRY ESTATE LTD for renewal of an Off Licence in respect of premises situated at 4132 Ocean Beach Road, Featherston, known as "**Wharekauhau Country Estate**".

The applicant also seeks to vary the licence conditions in accordance with s.120 of The Act.

Specify variations

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act. We renew the licence until , that being * three years from the first anniversary of the licence / the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

CONDITIONS

The following conditions are consistent with the style of on licence sought:

1. No alcohol is not to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person
2. Alcohol may be sold and supplied on the premises on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00 pm
3. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
4. The licences must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons

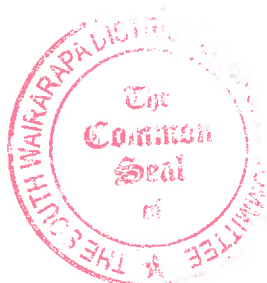

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17-20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), **Wharekauhau Country Estate Ltd** is authorised to sell or deliver liquor on or from the premises situated at **4132 Ocean Beach Road, RD 3, Featherston 5773**, known as **Wharekauhau Country Estate**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of liquor on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

The following conditions are consistent with the style of on licence sought:

1. No alcohol is not to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person
2. Alcohol may be sold and supplied on the premises on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00 pm the following day
3. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
4. The licences must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons

CONCLUSION

The application is complete and appears to meet the criteria for renewal of the OFF licence with the variation to reduce the hours as requested.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **4132 Ocean Beach Road, RD 3, Featherston 5773**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee** on **18th December 2014**.

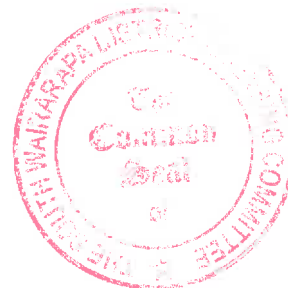
DURATION
