

ON-LICENCE

(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), **The Ferry Limited** is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at **2 Lake Ferry Road, RD 2, Lake Ferry, Featherston** and known as **"The Lake Ferry Hotel"**, to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a **Hotel and Restaurant-bar**.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

The licence is subject to the following conditions

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
 - a. Monday to Sunday **9.00am to 1.00am** the following day and
 - b. At any time on any day to any person (guest) for the time being living on the premises.
2. No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person other than a person who is on the premises to dine or is lodging on the premises.
3. The following parts of the premises are designated
 - a. The area marked "Bar" on the attached plan is designated **supervised**, the area marked "Restaurant" is **undesigned**.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.
7. A properly appointed certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
8. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
9. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of on-licence.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **2 Lake Ferry Road RD 2 Lake Ferry Featherston**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on **30 September 2016**

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **2 Lake Ferry Road, RD 2, Lake Ferry, Featherston** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

(a) Either –

- i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but

(b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –

- i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or

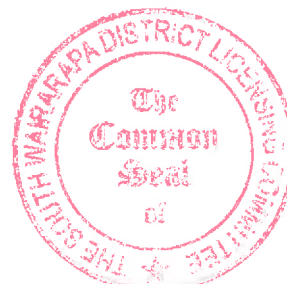
If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

DECISION

This is an application by **The Ferry Limited** for an on-licence in respect of premises situated at **2 Lake Ferry Road, RD 2, Lake Ferry, Featherston**, known as "**The Lake Ferry Hotel**".

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a **Hotel and Restaurant-bar**.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-licence authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

The licence is subject to the following conditions

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
 - a. Monday to Sunday **9.00am to 1.00am** the following day and
 - b. At any time on any day to any person (guest) for the time being living on the premises.
2. No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person other than a person who is on the premises to dine or is lodging on the premises.
3. The following parts of the premises are designated
 - a. The area marked "Bar" on the attached plan is designated **supervised**, the area marked "Restaurant" is **undesignated**.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.

7. A properly appointed certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
8. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
9. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.

The conditions sought are consistent with the style of on-licence.

The applicant's attention is drawn to ss.56, 57 and 214 (3) of the Act obliging the holder of an on-licence to display:-

1. At each principal entrance to the premises a sign attached to the inside or outside of the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol; **AND**
2. A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance; **AND**
3. A sign prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
